UKRAINIAN CHILDREN'S AND YOUTH CAMPS



Thanks to the generous gifts of individuals and churches throughout the U.S., we were able for the first time to offer two Ukrainian children's camps this year in Ostroda. The first week with 61 Ukrainian children was entitled, "Exodus," and focused on the freedom that is ours through Jesus. The second week with 59 Ukrainian teens was called, "Unplugged," and encouraged the youth to plug into Jesus and not be enslaved to social media. Teams from Illinois, Florida, Indiana, and Rhode Island joined our interns and other partners to serve at these camps. We are so thankful for the 10 Ukrainian counselors who stayed for both camps and provided such wonderful leadership. Our prayers are with all of these children as they continue to grow in the grace and knowledge of our Lord Jesus.
